Pavement restoration work at Manor Place, N.W. from Park Place, N.W. to Warder Street, N.W.

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will begin a Roadway Resurfacing (sidewalk, curb, gutter, wheelchair ramps, milling and paving), project along **Manor Place, N.W. from Park Place, N.W. to Warder Street, N.W.**, on or about Monday, February 29, 2016. It is estimated that this work will take approximately twenty one (21) days to complete, **weather permitting**.

If weather conditions, schedule changes or unforeseen issues do not permit our contractor to begin this work on the date stated above, the new start date for construction will be posted on the **No Parking Signs** located on the poles and trees throughout the construction project site.

Throughout the construction area, at least one lane of traffic will be maintained. Access to the adjacent businesses and houses will also be maintained. Curbside parking will be restricted at this location during construction hours. **"NO PARKING" signs will be posted seventy-two (72) hours prior to the commencement of construction in your area. All residents in this area will receive a copy of this letter alerting them to this work.** All work will be conducted from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Saturday.
