Installation of All-Red Pedestrian Phase and No Turn on Red Restrictions at the Intersection of 14th Street and Irving Street, NW – Ward 1

Dear Commissioner Boese:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D. C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

 Installation of All -Red Pedestrian Phase and No Turn on Red Restrictions at the Intersection of 14th St. and Irving St., NW – Ward 1

Currently, the intersection of 14th St. and Irving St., NW is controlled by a traffic signal. The Crosstown Multimodal Transportation Study conducted in 2016 recommended installation of an all-red phase to reduce the conflicts between pedestrian and vehicular traffic navigating through the intersection of 14th St. and Irving St., NW. Following the planning study recommendations, DDOT conducted further traffic analysis and subsequently completed the intersection design to implement the recommended all-red phase. The all-red phase, also known as "Pedestrian Scramble" will be implemented along with diagonal crosswalks and "No Turn on Red" restrictions. New traffic signals, curb ramps and signage will be installed at this intersection to complement the Pedestrian Scramble.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Transportation
